COMMUNITY HOMELESSNESS REPORT SUMMARY

County of Lambton

2023-2024

The Community Homelessness Report (CHR) is an annual Reaching Home reporting deliverable that supports communities to prevent and reduce homelessness using a more coordinated, systems-based and data-driven response. The CHR was designed to support local discussions and decision making, using all of the information about homelessness currently available at the community level. Communities are encouraged to use their CHR data to develop clear plans of action that help them to reach their homelessness reduction targets and to leverage the collective efforts of service providers working across the community, regardless of how they are funded.

This is a summary of the CHR for the 2023-24 reporting cycle. It shows the community's self-assessment of Reaching Home implementation, which includes the following key components:

- meaningful collaboration between Indigenous and non-Indigenous partners (see Section 1);
- community-level governance, coordinated service delivery (Coordinated Access) and use of a Homelessness Management Information System or HMIS (see Section 2); and,
- an Outcomes-Based Approach (tracking community-level outcomes and progress against targets using person-specific data; see Section 3).

If the community was able to report on outcomes and targets, this CHR Summary also includes results for each of the five core outcomes of Reaching Home (see Section 4).

Per the Lambton County Coordinated Access Community Collabortive Table (CCT) "Terms of Reference" document, CCT membership is comprised of supervisor or manager-level staff that have knowledge of client situations as well as decision-making authority regarding the resources available from their respective agency. From the Sarnia-Lambton Native Friendship Centre (SLNFC), the Program Manager is a member of the CCT. Meetings of the CCT were done on a monthly basis for the fiscal 2023-24 year (excluding the month of July). At each CCT meeting, success stories are shared, current Coordinated Access "Collective Caseload Capacity" and "Resource Inventory" are updated, and "Action-Oriented Case Conferencing" items related to the By-Names Priority List (BNPL) are reviewed in a collaborative manner. The Sarnia-Lambton Native Friendship Centre (SLNFC) Housing Coordinator participated in the County of Lambton's HIFIS training in June 2023. Collaboration and networking occurred between SLNFC and community caseworkers regarding HIFIS quality improvements.
